If you would like to be baptized, please see Pastor John.

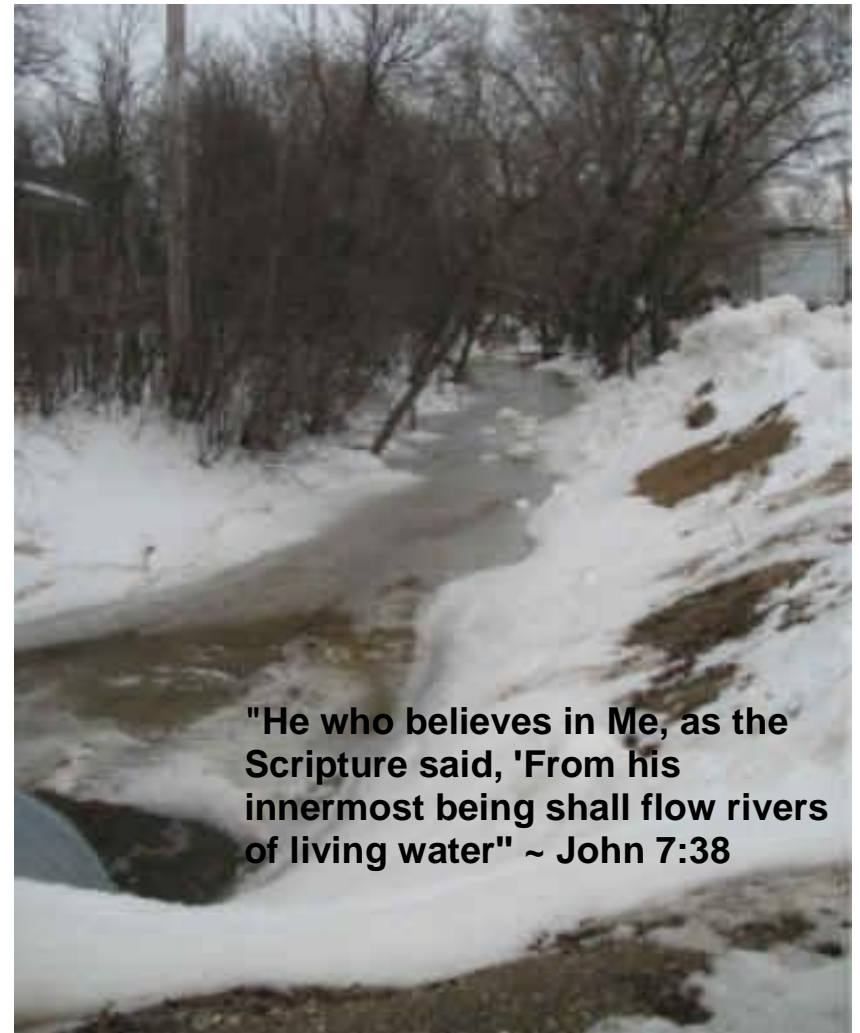
Remember our Five E's
